Section I: General Overview and Next Steps

As part of the GNSO Improvements Process, the GNSO Council has recommended the adoption of a revised GNSO Policy Development Process (PDP). This new Policy Development Process is described in the proposed Annex A to the ICANN Bylaws, and PDP Manual as outlined in the PDP Updated Final Report (see http://gnso.icann.org/improvements/updated-final-report-pdpwt-28sep11.pdf [PDF, 1.51 MB]).

The new GNSO Policy Development Process was developed by the Policy Development Process Work Team (PDP-WT), which was tasked with developing a new policy development process that incorporates a working group approach and makes it more effective and responsive to ICANN's policy development needs. The proposed recommendations seek to:

- Codify existing practices and procedures already utilized by the GNSO community in policy development processes (PDPs);
- Clarify existing rules, methods and procedures set forth in the ICANN Bylaws and GNSO Council's Operating Procedures;
- Suggest new approaches, methods and procedures to be used in the new policy development process.

The new GNSO Policy Development Process, if adopted by the ICANN Board, would replace the existing Annex A to the ICANN Bylaws in its entirety. Public comment on the proposed changes to Annex A of the ICANN Bylaws is necessary before Board consideration of these revisions. At its meeting in Dakar, Senegal, the Board approved the public comment posting of the proposed changes to Annex A. See: http://www.icann.org/en/minutes/resolutions-28oct11-en.htm#8. The Board will now consider the comments

received in conjunction with its consideration of the new GNSO Policy Development Process.
